A great part of people's lives in Ireland

- 1 When people go to Ireland, one of the first things that they see are the road signs¹, and these road signs are in English and Irish. In the Republic of Ireland all information must be in 5 English and Irish.

Two thousand years ago most people in Ireland spoke Irish. But then in the 16th century the English came and invaded² Ireland.

- From that time more and more people spoke 10 English. From the 19th century most people spoke English.

Today all children must learn Irish at school and many schools have some lessons in Irish and some in English. For this reason most people in



Pierce Brosnan

1 Pierce Brosnan wurde am 16. Mai 1953 als einziges Kind seiner Eltern in Drogheda in Irland geboren. Nach der Trennung seiner Eltern wuchs er bei Verwandten auf. Mit zwölf Jahren ging er zu seiner Mutter nach Schottland und später nach London.

5 Bevor Brosnan Schauspieler wurde, versuchte er sich als Maler, Straßenkünstler und sogar als Feuerschlucker im Zirkus. International berühmt wurde er mit der Krimi-Reihe „Remington Steele“. 1994 spielte er den Geheimagenten James Bond in „GoldenEye“. Es folgten drei weitere James-Bond-Filme mit Pierce Brosnan sowie 10 erfolgreiche Filme, darunter „Mars Attacks!“, „Dante's Peak“ und die Musicals „Mamma Mia!“ und „Mamma Mia 2: Here we go again“. Diese Filme boten ihm auch Gelegenheit, seine Gesangs- und Tanztalente zu zeigen.

Pierce Brosnan hat zahlreiche Auszeichnungen erhalten, darunter die Goldene Kamera für seine Arbeit für die Umwelt. Brosnan lebt heute in Kalifornien, USA, sowie auf einer Insel in Hawaii.




