What? Kiwi (fruit)

Where? regions: e.g. Northland, Bay of Plenty, Waikato

How many? more than 400,000 tonnes per year

Anything special? e.g.: doesn't come from New Zealand, but from China; got its name from the bird

What? Kiwi (bird)

Where? e.g. Nelson mountains, West Coast, Southern Alps

How many? about 68,000 kiwis left (in 2018)

Anything special? e.g. cannot fly; about as big as a chicken can live up to 50 years old



What? Silver fern

Where? mostly on North Island and northern South Island

How many? not known; about 200 fern species in NZ

Anything special? e.g. up to twelve metres tall; symbol of All Blacks rugby team; can easily be seen in the dark

What? Little blue penguin

Where? southern coast of NZ; also Australia

How many? about 350,000-600,000 in the whole world

Anything special? is exactly what its name says; smallest penguin in the world; maybe also the bluest ;-)
